5th Annual Bikini Rally a success!! \$25,310 was raised for Breast Cancer!! Our best year yet!! This year we held it at Brantling Ski Resort with Northeast Snowmobile Association. We rallied for Breast Cancer in the 25 degree weather with the sun shining all day. The hill that we had to climb, which was intimidating at first, but once the ladies got a run under their bikini bottoms, everyone loved it and rocked! We rode in pairs up the hill, for about an hour, then the hill climbing racing started. The pledges continued all day. 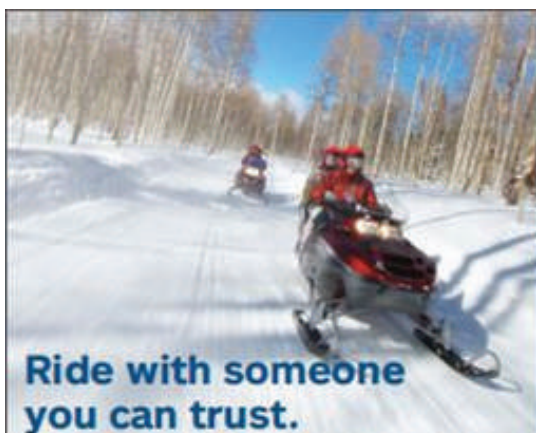
